Directions for Officials and Competitors.

OFFICIALS.

All officials for Swimming, Diving, and Water Polo will be identified by a number, details of which it is not yet possible to issue.

S W I M M I N G

Officials will be appointed each day for the Sessions on the following day.

By 1.0.p.m. each day a list of the Officials required the following day will be posted on the Notice Board outside the "F. I. N. A." Office situated on Pool level at LEFT OF SHALLOW END.

A copy of the list for retention by each Official appointed may be obtained from the "SECRETARIAT" Office on Pool Level at RIGHT OF SHALLOW END.

Forty five minutes prior to each daily Session the Arena Manager, Capt. B.W. Cummins, will issue Brassards to those Officials acting at that Session. At Thursday's Conference he will advise the point of Assembly for this purpose.

At the termination of each Session all Brassards must be returned to Capt. Cummins (or his Assistant - Mr. H. Windebank).

Judges and Time-Keepers' Recording Cards etc. will be issued by the Arena Manager at the same time as the Brassards.

The Technical Headquarters are comprised by an enclosure on Pool Level at rear of RIGHT OF STARTING BRIDGE.

Judges must report to the Chief Judge, Mr. Max Ritter at this enclosure at least THIRTY minutes before the first Swimming Event is due to start. They will then be allotted the number of their seat on the Judges' stand and retain these seats during the running off of the Contests.

Time Keepers must report to the Chief Timekeeper, Mr. S.T. Hirst at the same enclosure at least THIRTY minutes before the first Swimming Event.

Watches (with lanyards attached) will then be issued by Mr. J. Deschamps and each time Keeper will be required to sign for his watch.

All watches must be returned to Mr. Deschamps as soon as the last Swimming Event of the Session has been concluded. This is most important.

Watch readings must be retained until advised by the Chief TimeKeeper and it must particularly be noted that when NEW RECORDS are involved the Time Keepers concerned must submit their Watch Readings to the Chief Time Keeper for inspection.

Three Time Keepers will be allocated to each of the EIGHT LANES and all must sit on the Benches provided at the rear of the STARTING BRIDGE until the Competitor in their Lane is nearing the end of his swim. After taking the time, they must immediately return to their seats.

Four Reserve Time Keepers will be appointed for each Session and they will also sit on the Benches on the STARTING BRIDGE, one in Lane 1 one in Lane 3, one in Lane 5 and one in Lane 7.

These Reserve Time Keepers must set their watches in operation at the STARTERS SIGNAL.

In the event of any of the twenty four Time Keepers appointed to Lanes failing to function for any reason he must IMMEDIATELY report to the Head Lane Time Keeper who will in turn report to the Chief Time Keeper, who will transfer a Reserve Time Keeper to the Lane involved.

THE CHIEF WHIP must notify the REFEREE five minutes beforehand of any Competitors who have not been located for their Heat, Semi-Final or Final.

Verbal instructions as to the method of completing the Judges and Time Keepers ' Recording Cards, and general instructions to all other Technical Officials will be announced at the Conference to be held in the Restaurant at the Empire Pool at 10.0.a.m. on Thursday morning, 29th July.

To enable Semi-Finals and Finals to be worked out without interruption, or the carrying out of other Clerical duties, a Chief Recorder's Office (Swimming) has been provided at Pool Level at RIGHT OF DEEP END.

D I V I N G

Officials will be appointed the previous day.

By 1.0.p.m. a list of the Officials required the following day will be available at the Chief Recorder's Office (Diving) situated at Pool Level at RIGHT OF DEEP END.

Brassards will be issued by the Arena Manager as for Swimming and must be returned at termination of Session.

All necessary equipment must be obtained from the Chief Recorder's Office (Diving) THIRTY minutes before the first DIVING Event is due to start.

W A T E R P O L O.

The International Water Polo Board will meet each day after the Morning Session and again after the Evening Session to appoint the Water Polo Officials for the next day.

This information will be available at the Chief Recorder's Office (Water Polo) Wembley, situated at Pool Level at RIGHT OF DEEP END, at approximately 3 p.m. and 11p.m. each day, and it is most important that all Officials acquaint themselves with their duties. The success of the tournament depends on this.

Any Official unable to accept an appointment must, without delay, advise the Chief Recorder (Water Polo) - Mr. A. van Beets.

Brassards will be issued by the Arena Manager as for swimming and must be returned at termination of Session.

Teams and Officials will report at least 15 minutes before the commencement of each match to:-

Wembley - Mr. A. van Beets.
Finchley - Mr. R.C. Ross.

Team Managers will be provided with a form for the names of their team. These forms must be completed and handed to the Chief Recorder either at Wembley or Finchley 15 minutes prior to the commencement of a match in which their Country is engaged.

After each match the Referee, Goal Judges and Time Keeper must return to the Chief Recorder's Office to complete the form with the result and signature.

Water Polo equipment, such as Watch and Flags will be issued from the Chief Recorder's Office at both Wembley and Finchley 10 minutes prior to each match and must be returned to the Recorder's Office after each match.

Goal scorers must be responsible for collecting and returning the caps to the Office.

F.I.N.A. MARQUEE. For meetings of F.I.N.A. and any special Conferences of Officials, arrangements are endeavouring to be made for a special Marquee (with tables and chairs) to be set up in the grounds outside the DEEP END of the Pool.

All other Reporting Centres already referred to are clearly labelled and Officials should familiarise themselves with their location.

A D M I S S I O N T O P O O L L E V E L.

Only those Officials wearing Brassards will be admitted to Pool Level during each Sessional Period.

A special enclosure has been reserved on the RIGHT of Pool for Officials with F.I.N.A. Brassards, which admit to any part of the Pool at any time.

Accommodation For Officials When Not Acting.

Seats have been set aside in the East Terrace (behind the diving Stage).

Retiring Rooms for Officials.

Two Rooms for the convenience of MEN Officials have been set aside at Pool Level at RIGHT OF DEEP END, and two Rooms for WOMEN Officials at LEFT OF DEEP END.

COMPETITORS.

Dressing Accommodation for WOMEN has been provided at LEFT of Pool and for MEN at RIGHT.

The approximate time of each event will be advertised on the Notice Boards at entrance to Dressing Accommodation.

To ensure smooth running Competitors must anticipate their Events and be available ten minutes beforehand. The Contests cannot wait for them.

At the conclusion of each race they must remain at their finishing stations until released by the Referee.

After each FINAL the winners of the first three places must immediately take up positions on the ROSTRUM at SHALLOW END to receive Victory Medals.

Competitors are advised to bring sandals (or similar footwear) for transit from Dressing Accommodation to Pool Level.

ADMISSION TO POOL LEVEL

Only those Competitors taking part in a particular Session will be admitted to Pool Level during that Session.

ACCOMMODATION FOR COMPETITORS WHEN NOT TAKING PART.

Seats have been set aside in the East Terrace (behind the Diving Stage)

OFFICIALS AND COMPETITORS.

The Identity Cards will admit both to the Empire Pool and to the Empire Stadium.
